

FROM THE COLLECTIONS HOLD: Navigating the Seas with the National Geographic Society

This map cabinet, containing 19 roll-out maps, was gifted to Capt. James B. Sykes, USN in 1944 while in command of the USS *Bennington* (CV-20). The Essex-class aircraft carrier was a member of the United States Navy's Pacific Fleet, and earned three (3) Battle Stars during its service for its role in American actions against Imperial Japanese vessels during World War II.

Brazoria County Historical Museum acquired the map cabinet in 1996, and transferred custody to the Houston Maritime Museum. The National Geographic Society presented cabinets like this one to dignitaries. This a unique piece in the Museum's collection, and after many years on display, has been moved to storage for conservation purposes.
