How to Use

Step 1. Discuss what the word "maritime" is – it is an adjective that describes persons, things, or locations related to the sea or waterways to the sea.

Step 2. Set a timer and start the scavenger hunt. Students can either bring physical objects to a designated area or take pictures of the objects.

Step 3. Tally up the points.
